This matter came on to be heard this 5th day of February, 2014 at a regular meeting of the Board of Commissioners, at the request of Liane Welch, Tillamook County Public Works Director.

Being fully apprised of the records and files therein, the Board of Commissioners finds as follows:

1. As required by Board Order #14-003, the Director of Public Works is requesting to correct existing storm water damage to the Local Access Roads listed above caused in part by the lack of maintenance of County Road River View Drive.
2. Maintenance will include construction of a water ditch and culvert system sufficient to reduce the effect of future storm events.
3. It appears that the proposed maintenance will enhance public safety to the overall community and to the residents, and will also reduce flooding and erosion damage.
4. The work meets the following criteria noted in Board Order #14-003.
 - a. Elderberry Lane is a documented emergency evacuation route for the community.
 - b. Property owners will pay 25% of the estimated cost to perform these maintenance activities. The cost to the work to be done is estimated at \$48,000.
 - c. Determination from the Public Works Director that a county maintained road, i.e. River View Drive is part of the problem.
