ORDER

This matter coming on to be heard this 28<sup>th</sup> day of May, 2014, at a regular meeting of the Board of Commissioners, sitting as the governing body of the Solid Waste Service District (SWSD). Being fully apprized of the records and files herein, the Board finds as follows.

1. In accordance with Ordinance #4, Section 5.01 B. c., the Board may by ordinance or order establish rates for disposal sites that are uniform throughout the county or different rates for each site or class of sites.
2. Tipping fees for trash disposal at the Tillamook Transfer Station are established by this governing body, and were last changed on March 30, 2011 by Order 11-0113, SWSD Order 11-002.
3. Tipping fees for yard debris disposal at the Tillamook Transfer Station are established by this governing body, and were last changed on May 29, 2013 by Order 13-044, SWSD Order 13-006.
4. In accordance with a one-year trial designed to better harmonize waste disposal services at Tillamook County transfer stations, as outlined in a presentation by David McCall Solid Waste Program Manager, changes will be implemented in the funding structure of the transfer stations, a result of which results in the Board setting rates and collecting revenues for the disposal of trash, yard debris and asphalt roofing waste at the Tillamook, Pacific City, and Manzanita transfer stations beginning July 1, 2014.
5. As recommended in the Comprehensive Materials and Solid Waste Management Plan, it is the intent of the Tillamook County Solid Waste Program to encourage composting and implement a program for composting yard debris in Tillamook County.
6. As recommended in the Comprehensive Materials and Solid Waste Management Plan, it is the intent of the Tillamook County Solid Waste Program to encourage recycling of Construction and Demolition Debris and implement a program for the recovery of construction debris in Tillamook County.

7. The Tillamook County Solid Waste Advisory Committee (SWAC) at its May 13, 2014, meeting voted to recommend the establishment of a separate tipping fee for trash, yard debris, and asphalt roofing waste charged at the Tillamook, Pacific City, and Manzanita Transfer Stations, as outlined in the following point.

8. The proposed tipping fees would be:

a. Garbage/Municipal Solid Waste:

- i. \$71.50 per ton for franchise haulers
- ii. \$89.00 per ton for self-haulers to the Tillamook Transfer Station with a \$17.00 (up to 380 lb.) minimum fee
- iii. \$105.00 per ton for self-haulers to the Pacific City Transfer Station with an \$8.00 minimum fee (up to 152 lb.)
- iv. \$105.00 per ton for self-haulers to the Manzanita Transfer Station with a \$5.00 minimum fee (up to 95 lb.)

b. Yard debris:

- i. \$65.00 per ton for franchise haulers
- ii. \$75.00 per ton for self-haulers to the Tillamook Transfer Station with a \$10.00 (260 lb.) minimum fee
- iii. \$12.00 per cubic yard for self-haulers to the Pacific City Transfer Station
- iv. \$12.00 per cubic yard for self-haulers to the Manzanita Transfer Station

c. Asphalt roofing waste:

- i. \$61.50 per ton for franchise haulers
- ii. \$71.50 per ton for self-haulers to the Tillamook Transfer Station with a \$10 (280 lb.) minimum fee
- iii. \$80.00 per ton for self-haulers to the Manzanita Transfer Station

9. The Tillamook County Board of Commissioners finds that the proposed rate will be just, fair, reasonable and sufficient to provide the proper service to the public.

10. NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

11. Effective July 1, 2014, the fees charged for the disposal of solid waste at the Tillamook County Transfer Stations shall be established as follows:

a. Tillamook Transfer Station:

i. Garbage/Municipal Solid Waste:

1. \$71.50 per ton for franchise haulers
2. \$89.00 per ton for self-haulers with a \$17.00 (380 lb.) minimum fee

ii. Yard Debris:

1. \$65.00 per ton for franchise haulers

- 2. \$75.00 per ton for self-haulers with a \$10.00 (260 lb.) minimum fee
- iii. Asphalt Roofing Waste:
  - 1. \$61.50 per ton for franchise haulers
  - 2. \$71.50 per ton for self-haulers with a \$10.00 (280 lb.) minimum fee
- b. Pacific City Transfer Station:
  - i. Garbage/Municipal Solid Waste: \$105.00 per ton for self-haulers with a \$8.00 minimum fee
  - ii. Yard Debris: \$12.00 per cubic yard for self-haulers
- c. Manzanita Transfer Station:
  - i. Garbage/Municipal Solid Waste: \$105.00 per ton for self-haulers with a \$5.00 minimum fee
  - ii. Yard Debris: \$12.00 per cubic yard for self-haulers
  - iii. Asphalt Roofing Waste: \$80.00 per ton for self-haulers
