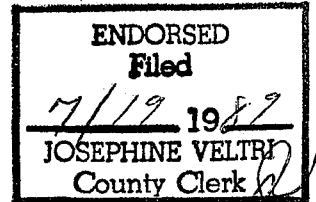

This matter coming on to be heard July 19, 1989 at a regular meeting of the Board of County Commissioners, at which time it appears that the U.S. Forest Service is proposing an exchange of certain forest lands with Boise Cascade Company of Monmouth, located in Yamhill, Lincoln, Lane and Tillamook Counties; and

WHEREAS, the exchange is authorized by Federal law identified as the Act of March 1, 1911 (Weeks Law), the Act of March 20, 1922 (General Exchange Law), and the Act of October 21, 1976 (Federal Land Policy and Management Act); and

WHEREAS, ORS 272.050 requires that before any such land be acquired for national forest, the consent of the governing body of the County wherein such land is located must be given by an order duly made and entered in the records of such governing body; and

WHEREAS, the proposed exchange would transfer approximately 499 acres of national forest land to Boise Cascade Company, in exchange for 80 acres of Boise Cascade land to be acquired as part of the Siuslaw National Forest, resulting in a net loss of approximately 419 acres of national forest lands within Tillamook County; and

WHEREAS, the net loss of 419 acres of national forest within Tillamook County will result in an annual loss of approximately \$12,000 to Tillamook County and its school districts, including an annual \$9,000 reduction to the County road fund, based on 1988

receipts of \$29 an acre; and

WHEREAS, the 499 acres of national forest going into private ownership will produce on a one time basis, only \$75,400 in severance taxes, of which the Tillamook County general fund would realize only about \$8161; and

WHEREAS, the net effect of the proposed land exchange therefore produces negative budget impacts for Tillamook County on an annual basis; and


WHEREAS, the recent Columbia River Gorge Congressional legislation has resulted in the potential loss of an additional three thousand acres of the Siuslaw National Forest within Tillamook County, with its attendant detrimental impacts to the Tillamook County budget; and

WHEREAS, the Tillamook County Board of Commissioners hereby finds that the proposed land exchange is not in the best interests of Tillamook County; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED that the Tillamook County Board of Commissioners, pursuant to ORS 272.050, opposes and disapproves of the proposed land exchange between Boise Cascade Company and the Siuslaw National Forest.


