WHEREAS, the enforcement, prosecution, adjudication, treatment and education components of the "Driving Under the Influence System" produces changes in social attitudes towards drinking and driving; and

WHEREAS, by working toward a common goal of fewer alcohol and drug related highway crashes, we may enjoy a safer road way system.
