At a regular meeting of the County Court on the above date, at which time were present Judge Harland Woods and Commissioner A. D. Thompson, the following business was transacted:

The County Court met with the Hospital Building Committee at which time a motion was made by Mr. Earl Pruitt to the effect that the Court should go ahead and condemn the property and it was seconded by Mr. Frank Owens.

Dr. Kauffman, temporary District Health Officer from Lincoln County, called on the Court.

Mr. Otto Effinberger met with the Court in regard to the Faucett Creek Road.

A committee called on the Court to help them decide on the appointment of the new commissioner from the south end of the county. Mr. George Winslow advised the Court and members of the committee that whoever is appointed will serve only until the next general election. The committee submitted only the name of Mr. Frank Owens but stated that they were not sure Mr. Owens would accept the appointment.

The Court attended the Tillamook County Welfare Commission meeting at 1:30 p. m.

Baker, Homer and Delsa - The West 45 feet of Lot 2 Block 10 Stillwell's Addition to Tillamook City. (Quitclaim deed)


Fisher, S. L. and Eva Birdie - Tract of land in Township 4 South Range 10 West, W.M. (Quitclaim deed)
