At a regular meeting of the County Court on the above date, at which time were present Judge Harland Woods and Commissioners A. D. Thompson and Wesley Schulmerich, the following business was transacted:

Messrs. Warren McMinimee, Harry Elliott and Thomas Bailey, representing the Tillamook Chamber of Commerce, met with the Court in regard to the possibility of securing a landing permit for commercial planes at the Naval Air Station. The Court advised them to contact the Tillamook County Aeronautical Board and present their problem to them to see what could be worked out. The County already has the usage of the airport by a contract with the Navy Department when certain conditions are met; primarily a fence around the operating area for use by the County.

Mr. F. F. Gerber called on the Court in regard to the Veterans' Housing Project in Garibaldi.

The Court attended the Tillamook County Welfare Commission meeting at 1:30 p. m.

Mr. John Weber stated that he would like some gravel on the Tillamook River Road.

Mr. Rudolph Fenk also requested gravel for the Trask River Fish Hatchery Road.

County Agent H. G. Smith and Dr. Lloyd met with the County Court in regard to the testing for Bang's Disease. They reported the following: At the beginning of this year, 709 of the 953 dairy herds in the County were clean--not infected with the disease. At the present time, of the 244 reactors at the beginning of the year, 66 are now clean. And 111 herd owners have gotten rid of their reactors but 67 owners have not.
