Shirley Joe and William W. Glasby, Lots 8 and 9 Block 5 Kiawanda Beach.


A contract for the purchase of Lots 5 through 8 Block 26 Classic Ridge Beach by A. H. and Anita Tilden was approved by the Court.


Mr. J. C. Bell of Rockaway talked to the Court about his contract for the purchase of a tract in Beal's Addition to Lake Lytle.
