At a regular meeting of the County Court on the date set above at which time were present County Judge H. Clay Myers and Commissioner C. Ernest Iseri, the following business was transacted.

Deed was executed to Carl and Frances Sanders for 5 lots in Classic Ridge Beach.

Hearing was held in the Matter of the Formation of the proposed Pacific City Sanitary District. Mr. George Goodrich, who represents the petitioners, gave a resume of proceedings since the petition was first filed. Mr. McMinimee appeared on behalf of Carl Hurliman, a portion of whose property had inadvertently been included in the amended petition. Mr. Hurliman had requested that his property be deleted, and the Court agreed to delete the farm property and did not realize that this included two lots in the Woods subdivision, which were included in the amended petition. Other persons present at the hearing included Florence Moore, W. J. Banks, Alvin W. Pearson, Ted Howe, R. Chambers, Emmett Kleinke, Harold M. Smith, Jessie M. Marchant, Georgia McCullough, Mr. and Mrs. Harvey Henderson, Mr. and Mrs. Ed Byerlee, Frank Hurliman, Majorie C. Wilson, Mae T. Coleman and Marian and Jess Sutton. After hearing those persons who wishes to comment on the proposed formation of the district, it was the decision of the Court to call the election according to the description appearing in the amended petition which was filed February 18, 1966. The Court agreed to honor a petition to be filed by Mr. Hurliman after the elction deleting Lots 6 and 7, Block 2, Woods.
