


Deed was executed to Richard and Agnes Wong for Lots 38 thru 44, Block 15, Seaview Park.

Fred Kremers met with the Court to discuss his logging activities on the Burton-Fraser Road. Mr. Kremers was advised that he must discontinue loading logs on the right of way and also that his haulers must provide a flagman for trucks turning from the Burton Fraser Road onto the Tillamook River Road at the south end of the Burton Bridge. He was also advised that he must post the two areas where he has a permit for access on the Burton-Fraser road for log trucks.
