
Hearing was held in the matter of the proposed Beachcombers Sanitary District, at 10:30 a.m., that being the time set therefor. There was some question as to the boundaries of the proposed district and the meeting was adjourned until 2:00 p.m. at which time the County Surveyor presented a map outlining the boundaries set forth in the petition. There were no objections to the boundaries. However, question was raised as to the suitability of the name 'Beachcombers Sanitary District'. The Court called for a showing of hands as to the propriety of changing the name to 'Netarts-Oceanside Sanitary District'. Those present voting in favor of the change, the Court directed that the name be changed to 'Netarts-Oceanside Sanitary District'. Persons attending the hearing were: William F. and Rosamond D. Kunze, Winston H. Taylor, W. M. Kean, Clair A. Peterson, Clare H. Edner and Percy L. Symons.




Mr. Hal Schlicting of Neskowin inquired as to the possible vacation of an old county road right of way thru his property.
