## Follow-Up from December 15, 2016 Meeting

### Requests for Assistance

#### 1. Benefit/Cost Analysis Training

- a. Angie Lane, State Hazard Mitigation Officer (SHMO), is planning BCA training for Fall 2017.

- c. Angie's advice:

- i. **START WELL AHEAD** of the application due date.
- ii. Some BCAs are simple and straightforward (e.g., replacing culverts, property acquisitions) and can be done on your own with the BCA tool.

#### 2. FEMA Grant Applications Training

- a. Angie Land, SHMO, is planning application trainings, potentially for Summer 2017.

3. Assist with designing a system for disseminating information during a disaster – FEMA declined.

#### 4. Develop public information products

- a. **Mitigating personal risk** – FEMA has already or is developing these.
- b. **Mitigating business/industry risk** – FEMA is interested in developing these.
- c. **Accessing mitigation assistance before, during, and after disasters** – FEMA may be interested in developing these.

#### 5. Assist with establishing a platform and process for making the Tillamook County MJNHMP a "living plan"

- a. FEMA declined. DLCD is working on doing this at the state level and will at some point be able to provide information and advice.

6. Assist with NHMP maintenance – FEMA (Risk MAP) declined. FEMA (Mitigation) or DLCD may be able to help. This is technically the responsibility of the jurisdiction.

- a. Develop and provide meeting materials
- b. Facilitate meetings
- c. Provide technical assistance as needed
