This matter came before the Board of Commissioners this 3<sup>rd</sup> day of February, 2010 at a regular meeting of the Board. Being fully apprized of the records and files herein, the Board finds as follows:

1. Within the law enforcement sector of state and local governments, advances in technology have enabled such agencies to convert from paper citations to e-tickets.
2. E-Tickets save time and money and are much more efficiently processed by courts.
3. Oregon State Police have converted from paper citations to e-tickets.
4. The Tillamook County Sheriff's Department is presently unable to afford the approximately Sixty Thousand (\$60,000) Dollar cost to convert to e-tickets, so it consequently continues to issue paper citations.
