Whereas, the Justice Court is not a court of record, and  
Whereas, under Oregon law, person to person conversations may not be recorded  
without the consent of all parties to the conversation, and  
Whereas, the court finds that recording devices interfere with the operation of the  
court, with the privacy of the litigants and witnesses, as well as spectators,

It is hereby

ORDERED that the use of any electronic devices to record, preserve, retain, or  
otherwise obtain, voices and images in the courtroom, or the areas of the courthouse  
utilized by court staff for the conduct of court business, as well as the waiting area for  
litigants and witnesses, and the transmittal of such recordings, is prohibited. Such  
devices may be seized by court staff and law enforcement personnel as evidence of  
criminal conduct.

Such prohibited conduct also includes the use of stenography.
