

## Cow cut out decoration

I used a cow because I was making a table decoration for my granddaughter's birthday and she loves cows, but, you could use anything.

### **Necessary (recommended items)**

Cereal or other cardboard box

Paper

Carbon paper

Paints or other coloring items of choice

Picture to trace (I found mine online)

Scissors

Imagination

Unfold/open the box so you have a large flat surface. I used the larger front and back sections for the major portion of the art and the smaller sides and tabs for the "feet" to make it stand. It really depends most on what you are drawing. You are only limited by your imagination!

Find your item you want to use and using the carbon paper, trace it onto the "clean" side of the box. I actually painted the whole "page" white so the tracing would be easier to see, but that of course is not necessary.

Cut out your piece and color it and viola! Done! I added the half-circle foot so my cow would stand.
