This matter coming before this board on this 15th day of April, 2009, at which time it having come to the attention of this board that there existed a condition of severe winter storm with snow, landslides, and mudslide events within Tillamook County during the period of December 13, 2008, through December 26, 2008. The severe winter storm event resulted in record snows whose run-off caused localized flooding along the Wilson, Trask, Nehalem and Nestucca Rivers, including many smaller tributaries and streams. This flooding severely impacted and caused damage to the County's road infrastructures. Other damages have been reported within the County that also needs immediate emergency actions,

AND FURTHER, that such condition presents a clear and present danger of great damage to the health and safety of the citizens and property of Tillamook County.

NOW THEREFORE the undersigned Board of Commissioners under the emergency powers granted by ORS 401.305 declare that a State of Emergency exists within Tillamook County and by this order directs the Office of Emergency Management for Tillamook County to take all necessary steps authorized by law to secure the persons and property of citizens of citizens of Tillamook County until further order of this Board.



The Board of Commissioners also requests the Oregon State Office of Emergency Management to provide additional state and federal resources for any applicable disaster recovery programs. Tillamook County has exhausted its resources and requests additional resources from the State of Oregon as needed to help respond to and recover from this flood event. We also request the Governor to exercise his emergency powers by setting aside any regulations or laws that are contrary to saving life and property during this emergency, by invoking ORS 401.065, (1), (2), (3) inclusive. This law shall go into effect if the Governor declares a State of Emergency for Tillamook County.


