This MATTER CAME BEFORE THE Tillamook County Board of Commissioners on May 6th, 2009 at the request of Todd Anderson of Tillamook County Sheriff, for a Notice of Intent to Award a Contract.

The Board being fully advised in the premises, records and files herein, makes the following findings:


1. Tillamook County advertised its Request for Proposals in the Headlight Herald, a local newspaper, on March 18, 2009 and in the Daily Journal of Commerce on March 19, 2009. Therefore, notice of solicitation for bids was properly published.
2. Tillamook County distributed nine (9) copies of its proposal solicitation documents in response to all telephone and personal requests for copies.
3. During the Request for Proposal period, Tillamook County received no objections or other concerns regarding the Request for Proposal documents timely raised by potential proposers or other interested persons. Two (2) Addendums were sent out to all proposers who requested the Bid Documents.
4. Tillamook County received three (3) proposals, of which only two (2) proposals were timely and met the minimum qualifications.
5. Therefore, it is in the best general health, safety and welfare interests of Tillamook County to award the Contract to the proposer who provided the best value and performance for the price.
6. The proposal of Pinnacle Public Services, LLC for the solicited project is accepted, subject to this decision becoming a final decision pursuant to local contracting rules.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

7. Notice of Intent to Award a Contract for the jail inmate telephone system be and is hereby adopted. The Board's Executive Secretary is directed to promptly send by first-class US Postal Service, a copy of this Order to the successful proposer and all plan holders who provided an address.

8. This Notice shall constitute a final decision of Tillamook County if no written protest of the Notice of Award is filed with Tillamook County at its Board of Commissioners' office, 201 Laurel Avenue, Tillamook, Oregon 97141, within seven (7) calendar days of the date of this Notice of Award pursuant to local contracting rules.
9. Pinnacle Public Services, LLC shall submit the required insurance certificates and executed Contract in order that a signed Contract is presented to the Board of Commissioners at its regular meeting on May 20, 2009.
10. Upon this decision becoming a final decision, all proposals not otherwise selected are rejected.




