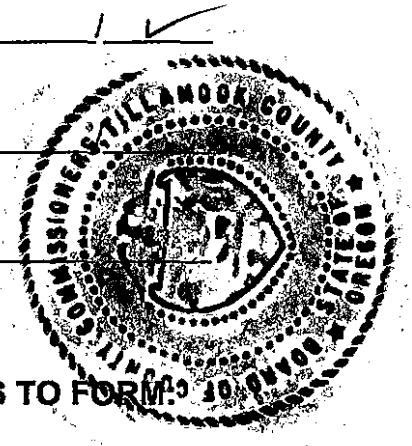

RE: Request for Rate Increase at Pacific City Recycling  
and Transfer Station

With much consideration, NVSS requests a rate increase for garbage collection at the **Pacific City Recycling and Transfer Station** on Brooten Road. The last rate increase took effect June 1, 2004. Garbage collection rates help finance recycling and therefore, we propose the following attached "menu" of new garbage fees. These fees are in line with the fees charged currently at CART'M the transfer and recycling facility in Manzanita.

The replacement of the garbage truck with the twenty yard, rear compaction unit with a twenty yard, fully enclosed compactor has required oversized solid waste such as furniture and mattresses to be off loaded into a thirty yard drop box which is then transported to Tillamook Transfer Station. This has led to the reassessment of fees of these large objects that were originally generically charged as regular garbage.

We will be working directly with Solid Waste Coordinator, Jennifer Purcell in updating the current facility to modestly enhance our services to the South Tillamook County area.
