This matter came before the Tillamook County Board of Commissioners this 3rd day of August, 2009, at the request of Butch Parker, Community Development Director.

Being fully advised of the representations of the above named person and the records and files herein, the Board finds as follows:

1. The issuance of building permits for structures outside the boundaries of public water systems requires verification that the applicant for such a building permit holds the water rights for the potable water to service the structure.
2. The verification for such water rights can only be accomplished by the State Water Master.
3. Tillamook County incurs certain costs and expenses in providing State Water Master services for such water rights verifications.
4. It is appropriate that Tillamook County collect a fee from such building permit applications in an amount sufficient to cover the County's costs and expenses for providing State Water Master services.



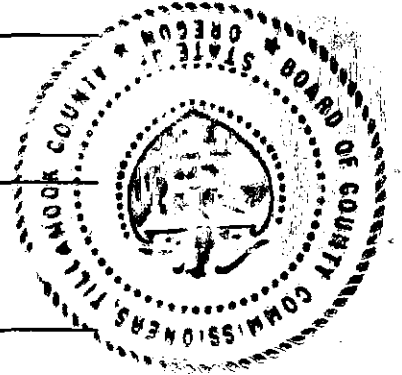
5. Butch Parker, Community Development Director, has determined that a \$75.00 fee for each such building permit applicant will be sufficient to cover Tillamook County's costs and expenses for providing State Water Master services.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT effective September 1, 2009, a \$75.00 fee be collected from each building permit applicant where a water rights certification is required.
