






An order ~~appointing~~^{drawing} Jury List for the year 1955 was signed.


Contracts were approved for the purchase of tracts on the Bayocean Road by John W. and Virginia D. Hathaway and Allen E. and Dora Birch.


Orders were signed vacating a portion of the townsite of Mohler and all of the townsite of Liverpool.
