
At a regular meeting of the County Court on the date set ab

business was transacted.


A Class A. Dispenser Liquor Application was approved for  
Anna B. and Clarence I. Ekborg of the Green Parrot.


Orders were signed re-appointing members of the Naval Airport

J. C. and Nellie F. Bell.


Ralph Ireland was appointed Justice of the Peace Pro-tem for
