Order cancelling certification of need for a five mill tax levy for oiling roads was signed and new order certifying need for 4 mill levy was presented to the County Clerk.


Order certifying need for one mill tax levy for two years for purpose of expanding 4-H buildings at fair grounds was delivered to the County Clerk.




The Court signed an order designating a speed limit of 35 miles an hour on the county road between Woods and Pacific City.
