Mary Rutherford, County Librarian, visited the Court with Miss Rosenberger, the new Bookmobile Librarian.


Mr. Robbins of Gleneden Brick and Tile Company talked to the Court.


Three Boy Scouts, Mike Isanhart, Eugene Gigoux and Bob Shartell, visited the Court to learn of its functions and duties.
