
Ted Jacobs talked to the Court about eliminating some of the hazards on the curves on Sollie Smith Road.


The Court signed an order directing that \$819 be transferred from the General Fund to the Road Oiling Fund to correct error in charging this amount against Jail Meals and Lodging.
