


Wednesday, December 17, 1958

At a regular meeting of the County Court on the date set above at which time were present County Judge O. E. Effenberger and Commissioner A. H. Tilden, the following business was transacted.

The Court signed an order directing that Bond of Justice of the Peace for the Second Justice District be increased from \$2500 to \$5000.

The Court signed a timber cutting agreement with Spaulding Pulp & Paper Company concerning an area originally assigned to them in Section 15, Township 1 North, Range 10 West, W.M.

Bill Phelos of the Forestry Department, Mr. Sorenson of Oregon-Washington and Mr. Cutright, logging operator, discussed the matter of replacing the Kansas Creek Bridge with the Court. Oregon-Washington was given permission to cut several trees from the Park Area in the West half of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 16, Township 1 South, Range 8 West, W.M. with which to repair the bridge for temporary use this winter.
