Mr. McMinimee and Mrs. McMurphy called on the Court to inquire about the building which the late Mr. McMurphy maintained on the Fairgrounds property at the site of the old county airport. Mr. McMinimee was referred to Mr. Vergets, the District Attorney, who is handling the matter for the Court.
