At a regular meeting of the County Court on the date set above at which time were present County Judge H. Clay Myers and Commissioners A. H. Tilden and L. C. Schulmerich, the following business was transacted.

Mrs. Bester, Mrs. Foster and Mrs. Peterson met with the Court to discuss the matter of a sidewalk along Third Street. The Court suggested that they talk to the City, as they felt that the proper place for such a sidewalk is on the south side of the street, which is in the city limits.

Melvin Rhodes of Publisher's Paper Company talked to the Court about a piece of county property adjacent to the rock quarry at Watseco, which the company would like to acquire. The Court told Mr. Rhodes they would look into the matter and discuss it again at a later date.

The Tillamook County Taxpayers Association met with the Court. The various committees of the association presented matters which they wanted clarified by the Court. The Court requested that the committees submit their questions in writing and suggested that each committee meet with the Court at a later date in order that the problems might be discussed after the Court has had an opportunity to gather the information requested.

Fred Troxel inquired as to garbage dump attendants which were hired by the County. He was advised that the attendants had been discharged.

Otto Schild inquired as to the Road Department Cost Accounting system and was advised that it had been in operation for some time. Judge Myers offered to accompany him to the Road Department Office to look at the records if he did not wish to go alone.

Paul Hanneman, representing the Pacific City-Woods Chamber of Commerce advised the Court that their organization would work closely with the Court in order to promote the welfare of the county.
