At a regular meeting of the County Court on the date set above at which time were present County Judge H. Clay Myers and Commissioners A. H. Tilden and L. C. Schulmerich, the following business was transacted.

Mr. Phares and Bill Fouste met with the Court to discuss the matter of timber to be cut on the Garibaldi Watershed property in connection with dam and pipe line improvements to the Garibaldi Water System. The Court advised these gentlemen that they would talk to Stu Wells about the matter before taking any action.

Mr. Don Norris, Allen Kofoed and Robert Wilson met with Mr. Schulmerich and Mr. Tilden to discuss various county matters. They inquired as to why a check was drawn in payment of salary to Otto Effenberger in February and were advised that this was in payment for January 1 to January 7 when he retired from office. They also inquired about the rebuilding of the hangar at the airport and the status of the Bewley Creek Road which Crown Zellerbach is maintaining.

Bob Politte of the Oceanside Fire Department inquired as to whether or not the county would allow \$100 for fireworks this year. No answer was given at this time. He was also advised that the County cannot be responsible for a stairway which might be built south of the new fire equipment building.

Gene Hoover called on the Court to offer information as to the plastering at the hospital.
