At a regular meeting of the County Court on the date set above at which time were present County Judge H. Clay Myers and Commissioners A. H. Tilden and L. C. Schulmerich, the following business was transacted.

Hearing was held in the matter of establishing and relocating the Nehalem River to Clatsop County Line Road. Jack Erickson, Paul Latham, Kenneth Christensen (representing Mr. Yunker) and Warren Peterson and Bill Phelps of the State Forestry Department attended the hearing. Mr. Yunker requested a reduction in the width of the right of way from Stations 80 through 85. The Court agreed to this change and the matter was accepted.

George Goodrich, Eldon Bedford and Carlos Douglas called on the Court on behalf of the Housing Authority. They stated at inasmuch as appointments to the authority expired March 25, 1963, the committee has passed a resolution dissolving the authority. However, it now appeared that there was unfinished business and they suggested that the authority be reactivated and the committee reappointed for a period of six weeks in order to allow for winding up the affairs of the authority. The Court agreed to re-appoint the committee on such a basis.

Resolution was signed accepting and establishing Nehalem River to Clatsop County Line Road.

Order was signed re-appointing members of the Tillamook County Housing Authority.
