Mr. John Dietrich of the U.S. Wildlife Service called on the Court to inquire as to whether we had had any complaints of dogs being caught in the Predator's traps.

Kenwood Press and Coast Printing submitted bids for printing the booklet "Let's Crab in Tillamook County. The job was awarded to Coast Printing, whose bid of \$840 was \$55 under Kenwood Press bid of \$895.

Daughter of N. P. Hanson called on the Court to request that the road being established and referred to as Fletcher Road be renamed \$Hanson Road at the time the Order establishing the road is signed. The Court agreed. The County Assessor's records already show the road as the N. P. Hanson Road.

Tom Edwards and Roy Dye talked to the Court about taking a contract for picking up refuse cans at the County Parks in the south end of the County. More information will be obtained before a bid is submitted.

O. E. Effenberger called on the Court to say that Vern Ayres has had a stroke and to ask if funds could be allowed to pay Mr. Effenberger's expenses for lobbying at the legislature. No action was taken.

George R. Goodrich submitted his resignation as a member of the Tillamook County Housing Authority, effective as of 4 p.m. this date. Resignation was accepted by the Court.
