At a regular meeting of the County Court on the date set above at which time were present County Judge H. Clay Myers and Commissioners ~~XXXXXXXXXXXX~~ and L. C. Schulmerich, the following business was transacted.

A hearing was held on the establishment of the Adolph Schild Road. Mr. Bennett and Mr. Hallstrom, property owners along the proposed road were present at the hearing. Mr. Hallstrom was represented by George Winslow, Jr. A petition of remonstrance was filed by Mr. Hallstrom owing to the fact that Crown Zellerbach has an easement from the Schild's which might lead to the County Road, if established, being used for log hauling. Inasmuch as the County was taking over the road only in order to be able to maintain it for the property owners involved, the matter was dropped and no action toward establishing the road will be taken at this time.

Paul Hanneman talked to the Court about budgeting money for the signs which the Marine Board advised should be posted on the Nestucca River.

Mr. and Mrs. Ed Byerlee offered \$5000 for 6 lots in the Haystack Heights subdivision. The Court will consider the matter after having been advised by the Assessor's Office of the appraisal which they put on the lots in question.

Bill Easton visited the Court to inquire whether or not they would accept his offer of \$7500 for a portion of the lots in the Brighton Beach Subdivision. He was advised that the Court had not yet had time to discuss the matter and could not do so until Mr. Tilden returned May 22.
