


County Sanitarian Maxwell met with the Court to discuss a letter he had received from a property owner in Pacific City requesting that his property be excluded from the proposed Pacific City Sewer District.

Mr. Tibbetts and the Court discussed the permit requested by Maller Brothers to haul overlength poles and piling for Crown Zellerbach from Clarence, East and Moon Creeks to the Air Base or Astoria. The permit is to be granted for a length up to 105 feet. Steering trailer will be required for loads 80 feet and over and two flagmen as required by State regulations.

Mr. Ausved and Mr. Barnes of GSA met with the Court and the members of the airport commission to discuss disposition to be made of some parcels of land at the former Tillamook Naval Air Station.

Mr. Van Buren reported to the Court a violation in connection with rebuilding on property up the Trask River.
