Contract was approved for the purchase of Lots 21 thru 24, Block 18 Tillamook Beach, by Donah Porter.


Order was signed in the matter of accepting Deed for county road purposes from Robert and June Crawford & B. C. Lamb.


Lester E. Braddock was appointed to the Tillamook County Hospital Board to fill the vacancy due to the death of Luther Crocker.
