At a regular meeting of the County Court on the date set above at which time were present County Judge H. Clay Myers and Commissioners L. C. Schulmerich and C. Ernest Iseri, the following business was transacted.

Ivan Koeber discussed with the Court his application for a dance hall license at Pacific City. The Court advised Mr. Koeber that a petition signed by twenty-nine residents of the area had been presented to the Court asking that something be done to alleviate the noise and confusion caused by patrons of his establishment on dance nights. Sheriff Walpole joined the discussion and agreed to furnish two posse members who would be deputized and use a county vehicle, but whose wages for the evening would be paid by Mr. Koeber (8 Or 9 to 1). It is hoped that the deputies would be able to keep things under control in the parking area near the dance hall where most of the commotion originates. The Court then approved the license.
