Bills were signed for payment.

Order was signed surrendering portion of the old Wheeler-Mohler County Road to the City of Wheeler.

Agreement was entered into with Kenneth and Barbara Bell, Thomas W. and Lorena C. Weber regarding an addition to the Latimer Road right-of-way.

Mr. Cohee called on the court and approval was given for him to start as manager of the Bay City County Dump on the 15th of May, 1966. The court contacted Glenn Merritt, who is presently doing tractor work at the dump, informing him of such. Glenn Merritt will be paid for his participation through the end of May, 1966.

Basil Edmunds called on the court to present thank you letters from various persons and organizations on the matter of the South Jetty.

Mr. Wilson of the State Highway Department, Astoria, visited the Court to discuss the matter of acquiring some property on the Nehalem Spit for State Park purposes.
