At a regular meeting of the County Court on the date set above at which time were present County Judge H. Clay Myers and Commissioners L. C. Schulmerich and C. Ernest Iseri, the following business was transacted.

Carl Bendscheidt, Ken Wilson and Jack McGuire called on the Court to inquire if the Chamber of Commerce would be given \$2000 from the advertising fund as the Chamber is low on funds with which to hire a new manager. The Court explained that the County could only spend advertising funds for advertising services actually performed and requested a billing quarterly from the Chamber giving an itemized statement of advertising services expended for the County.


Mr. Morris of Winema discussed with the Court the matter of sheep he is losing either to dogs or wild animals.

Sheriff Walpole discussed with the Court the matter of paying prisoners at the rate of \$1.00 per day for work in and around the Court House. The Court agreed the sum is reasonable, providing funds are available in the Court House Fund for such services.

Mark Chase called on the Court to present a petition to lay a sewer line across the road right of way in Manhattan.
