At a regular meeting of the County Court on the date set above at which time were present County Judge H. Clay Myers and Commissioners L. C. Schulmerich and C. Ernest Iseri, the following business was transacted.

Jerry Louder, engineer for Lloyd Hill/ Contractor/ discussed with the Court the matter of setting up a crushing site on the Kostic property and using the present county road for the operation and building a detour through the Kostic property rather than have traffic on the road stop for equipment crossing the present road. The Court and the Roadmaster agreed that this would be the most satisfactory arrangement and requested that a bond of \$5000 be posted to insure the road being rebuilt in its present condition at the end of the crushing operation. The County will be willing to do the paving next spring, but the contractor must put back the base and pay the cost of the paving. Mr. McEwen and Mr. Shaw ~~of the above firm~~ called on the Court a little later to learn what arrangements Mr. Louder had made and requested permission to use overloads on the road. The Court did not grant permission for overloads.

Percy Symmons, who is platting property in the Oceanside area called on the Court to discuss the status of his request for an underwidth road on part of the plat. The Court advised Mr. Symmons that a letter approving the plat with the road width requested had been sent to the Planning Commission some months ago.

Order was signed directing that deeds be executed to H. E. and Jessie P. Prickett and Phillip C. and Gladys W. Cushman, in accordance with agreement with Landeda Inc. when land was deeded to County to change alignment of Beach Street in Second Addition to Manzanita Beach.
