



Temporary dance hall permit was granted to Nestucca Rural Fire Protection District.

Dale Freidman inquired as to whether anything could be done to curtail litter blowing from vehicles hauling refuse to the Tillamook Dump.

At a regular meeting of the Board of Commissioners on the date set above at which time were present Chairman R. F. Brennan and Commissioners F. E. Knight and Chas D. Bailey, the following business was transacted.

Order was signed in the matter of prohibiting motor vehicles on county-owned property south of Galloway Road.

Relinquishment of title to county-owned park lots in Garibaldi, Park, Block 1, and Russell Hawkins Second Addition to Garibaldi, Block 6, was signed transferring title to the City of Garibaldi.

Deed was granted to Robert Cogburn and John Gulan for 7 lots in Block 16, Manhattan Beach.

Frank Olson and Wendell Jones, Siuslaw National Forest, discussed with the commissioners proposed plans for the forest park at Sandlake and also requested that the county enter an order in the matter of prohibiting motor vehicles on county land south of the Galloway Road, as the Forest Service will prohibit motor vehicles on Forest Service land in the same area.

County Librarian Ruth Lundy advised the commissioners that it would be necessary to budget for the salary of a clerk typist who is presently paid from federal funds while she is working on a catalog. She will be working on the project for about one more year, and the grant of funds will not be allowed another year.

Order was signed in the matter of conveying Lot 9, Block 4, Haystack Heights to the Pacific City Water District at no charge for the purpose of installing a pumping station thereon.

Gasoline and oil bids were opened. Texaco, Inc. was awarded the contract for Premium Gasoline at .2309 and Regular Gasoline at .2017. Phillips Petroleum was awarded the contract for Diesel at .127. Fuel oil contract was not awarded as only one bid was tendered.

Order was entered declaring Tillamook County a disaster area after the wind storm of January 14 and 15, 1971.

Dr. Gilberts met with the commissioners to discuss funds which will be necessary to carry out the pre-school examination program next summer.
