At a regular meeting of the Board of Commissioners on the date set above at which time were present Chairman R. F. Brennan and Commissioners F. E. Knight and Chas D. Bailey, the following business was transacted.

Lewis Forster and Rachel Stacy were re-appointed to the Tillamook County Library Board.

Temporary Dance Hall Permit was granted to the Swiss Society.

Hearing was had on the proposed incorporation of Neskowin. A petition signed by 40 registered voters residing within the boundaries of the area petitioned to be incorporated, and who are not in favor of the incorporation, was presented at the hearing. About thirty-five persons attended the hearing, and inasmuch as there seemed to be more objections to the proposed incorporation than approval thereof voiced, the matter was continued until a later date which has not yet been designated.

Hearing was held in the matter of a Zone Change requested by Harold Schlicting from R-1 to C-1 on a portion of his property east of Highway 101. Walter Carbaugh objected to the proposed change. Lester Fultz, Bill Kanoff and Kurt Ramme expressed agreement with the proposed change. The Commissioners agreed with the Planning Commission to allow the zone change and so voted.
