




Plat of Deer Ridge was approved.


Contract was approved for the purchase of Lots 9 thru 17, Block 9, Mohler by John S. and Marie G. Howes.


Deed was executed to Bruce M. and Anna M. Merritt for Lot 9, Block 69, Pacific Addition to Bay City.


Meeting with representatives of Emergency Services and cities throughout the county was held to discuss implementation of a plan for the county to best serve in times of disaster. The county representatives present voted to have the Division of Continuing Education assist with setting up a plan and the date of March 29 was tentatively set for calling an instructional meeting.
