Order was signed in the matter of appointing Chuck Littlehales Deputy District Attorney.

Don Hickman, Mike Stewart, and Millard Trout, met with the Commissioner to discuss the bridge across the trask which Mr. Hickman and Mr. Stewart are buying and having moved to the Trask location to give access to Wagner subdivision and the Camp Fire Girls Camp. The County agreed to pave the bridge and the approaches from the Trask River Road to the start of the subdivision. Hickman and Associates will furnish the county a 50 foot right of way thru the subdivision to Camp Fire Girls Camp (approx 2400 feet) and prepare road bed 20 feet wide with crushed rock reading for oiling. County will oil road for Hickman and Associates, who will pay county for oiling job. Planning and Zoning will determine if road meets specifications for area to camp.
