Bernard McCusker discussed plans for roads in his Camelot subdivision.


Order was signed in the matter of changing names of certain streets in Hawk Creek Hills subdivision.

Order was signed directing that a stop sign be installed on Nedonna Avenue at the junction of Beach Street in Nedonna Subdivision.


Notice was signed in the matter of advertising hearing on proposed nuisance ordinance for Tillamook County.
