

Order was signed in the matter of designating Fidelity Savings & Loan a depository for county funds.


Amended resolution signed in the matter of the vacation of an unnamed alley in Neah-Kah-Nie Mountain subdivision.

Gaylord Shively requested that the county do some paving for his subdivision. He was advised to contact a private contractor.


Commissioners and Roadmaster inspected drainage problem in the Hughey Lane area, as well as looked at some roads and other matters in the Netarts-Oceanside area.




