




Mr. Eldon Everton, District Engineer, Mr. Gix of the State Highway Department and a representative of the Federal Highway System, discussed with the commissioners the matter of bridge inspection which is required by the new Federal Bridge Standards. All bridges on F.A.S. roads over 20 feet long must be inspected by December 31, 1971. An inventory of bridges is due in April, 1972.

Mr. Glade Janes showed the commissioners a drawing of his proposed subdivision, which will include tracts of over one acre and embody green belts, etc.

Lester Fultz presented the commissioners with preliminary copies of the sanitary landfill engineering study which he was hired to make for the county.
