




Mr. Bailey later advised Mr. Tibbetts of the complaints and requested that he furnish a plan as soon as possible.



Contract was approved for the purchase of Lots 1 thru 5 and 21 and 22 Block 17, Rockaway Beach, by Homer Sheldon, Jr.


Elizabeth Merrill was appointed Deputy District Attorney to act while Mr. Werdell attends a meeting of District Attorneys.

DB liquor license renewal approved for Bay Enterprise, Cloverdale.


