At a regular meeting of the Board of Commissioners on the date set above at which time were present Chairman R. F. Brennan and Commissioners F. E. Knight and Chas D. Bailey, the following business was transacted.

December 9, Mr. Bailey and Mr. Heckeroth investigated road projects along county roads where it was reported the road crews had dumped slide material in to the streams. They were unable to find evidence of such activity by the road department.

Liquor license renewal applications were approved for Alderbrook, Inc., RMBB, Alderbrook Golf Course; Robert and Muriel Swain, Gold Coast Market, PB. Joseph and Ruth Renner, Manhattan Grocery, PB.


Mr. Jack Johnson and Mr. Al Wright of the State Water Resources Board met with the Commissioners and Planning Director Richard Smith and Archie Pye to discuss the matter of the waters draining into the Tillamook Basin, on which they expect to have a hearing in June, 1972. They suggested that Tillamook County again activate a Water Resources Committee to investigate needs in the County and indicated that technical assistance could be provided to the committee by the State Water Resources Board. The Commissioners will consider the matter and appoint a committee. Mr. Pye will lend assistance in finding committee members.


Mr. Henry Schild discussed with the commissioners the need to vacate an old county road thru his property. He will have his attorney prepare the necessary papers.


