MINUTES - TILLAMOOK COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS' SPECIAL MEETING
Monday, June 1, 1987

ITEM NO. 1: CALL TO ORDER: By Chairman Kinkade at 9:00 a.m. in the Commissioners' Conference Room.

ITEM NO. 2: DISCUSSION CONCERNING MILLS BRIDGE TIMBER SALE CONTRACT: Ms. Powell said the State Forestry will probably not approve logging on sections of the Mills Bridge Timber Sale. She spoke with Mike O'Brian from State Forestry who said the State has two areas of concern and will bring in geographic technicians today to view the area.

The first problem area involves four to five acres with two streams. The land is steep and unstable, and there were slides in the same area last year. Ms. Powell said the State Forestry will probably not allow any yarding by those streams.

The other concern was the five to six acres valued at \$12,490 on the ridge. The State said there is no way to log from the one landing. The area has a 70-80% slope, and the State will probably not approve a skid road to take a yarder up there. The only alternative is to use a swing yarder.

Commissioner Woodward said the logging on the ridge could be done, but it will take extra line. Ms. Powell said Nygaard and the State Forestry felt it was impossible.

The Commissioners viewed the area on a 3-D aerial photograph.

The Commissioners felt it wasn't worth taking a chance on the area with the streams, but felt the ridge could be logged.

Ms. Powell will inform Nygaard the county would be agreeable to contract negotiating.

Chairman Kinkade adjourned the meeting at 9:30 a.m.
