CALL TO ORDER: By Chair Cameron at 5:04 p.m.

ITEM NO. 1: CONSIDERATION OF ORDER DESIGNATING A STATE OF EMERGENCY WITHIN TILLAMOOK COUNTY DUE TO THE MASSIVE FAILURE & COLLAPSE ON SANDLAKE ROAD AT MILE POST 10.4, JUST SOUTH OF THE COMMUNITY OF TIERRA DEL MAR: The Board discussed the seriousness of the collapse caused by coastal erosion of the road. It covered approximately a 250-foot stretch of the road.

Commissioner Josi moved to sign the order, Commissioner Firman seconded, passed with three eye votes.

The Commissioners signed Order #99-15.

The Board discussed the erosion problems up and down the Tillamook County coastline and the conditions just north of this particular location, which were repaired 6-8 years previously.

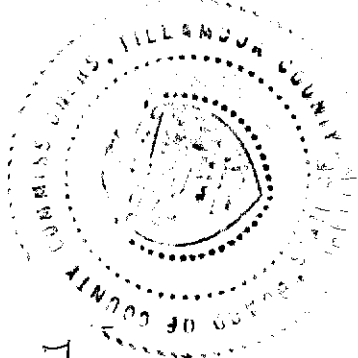
Mr. Oshel joined the meeting stating that the slide was now 5-6 times worse since the morning. The road had pushed out onto the beach for approximately 200 feet. Damages on this one slide exceeded \$1 million. The Board discussed plans for meeting the following week with State and Federal highway geologists, as well as with the Pacific City Chamber of Commerce.

Chair Cameron adjourned the meeting at 5:22 p.m.
