CALL TO ORDER: By Chair Hurliman at 9:00 a.m. in Commissioners' Meeting Room A.

ITEM NO. 1: WELCOME & REQUEST TO SIGN GUEST LIST: Chair Hurliman welcomed everyone and reminded them to sign the guest list.

ITEM NO. 2: PUBLIC COMMENT – NON-AGENDA ITEMS: There were none at this time.

TAKEN OUT OF ORDER ITEM NO. 14: CONSIDERATION OF FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY (FEMA) MATCH APPLICATION AND FEMA OREGON ECONOMIC AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT (OEM) MATCH APPLICATION SUPPLEMENT: Liane Welch said this is for our twenty-five (25%) percent match for FEMA eligible projects. This will provide Twenty-Nine Thousand Three Hundred Eighty-Nine (\$29,389) Dollars for projects we can't initiate until we receive these funds. Vice-Chair Josi said these funds are sorely needed. Ms. Welch said asphalt cost has doubled in three (3) years.

A motion was made by Vice-Chair Josi to approve and sign the FEMA Match Application and the FEMA OEM Match Application Supplement. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Labhart. The motion carried with three (3) aye votes. Chair Hurliman signed the Application.

ITEM NO. 15: CONSIDERATION OF INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT (NO. 20656) WITH THE OREGON DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR EQUIPMENT AND SERVICES: Ms. Welch explained this will provide for shared services and an exchange of services.

Vice-Chair Josi made a motion to approve and sign the Intergovernmental Agreement (No. 20656) with the Oregon Department of Transportation for equipment and services. Commissioner Labhart seconded the motion. The motion carried with three (3) aye votes. Chair Hurliman and Vice-Chair Josi signed the Intergovernmental Agreement.

ITEM NO. 3: PRESENTATION ON THE COMMISSION ON CHILDREN AND FAMILIES' SUMMER MEALS PROGRAM: Laurie Fox, Summer Meals for Kids, distributed the new brochures. The free meals start next week. It is free for all children. Tillamook County won an award for this program. She showed a display with all twenty-two (22) sites in the County. Volunteers are needed in Wheeler and Garibaldi. The Commissioners thanked Ms. Fox.

TAKEN OUT OF ORDER ITEM NO. 9: CONSIDERATION OF ORDER APPOINTING STACY LORETTE TO THE COMMISSION ON CHILDREN AND FAMILIES BOARD: Marlene Putman said Stacy Lorette was recommended by the Commission on Children and Families. She works for DHS as a supervisor for child welfare.

Commissioner Labhart made a motion to approve and sign the Order appointing Stacy Lorette to the Commission on Children and Families Board. The motion was seconded by Vice-Chair Josi. The motion carried with three (3) aye votes. The Commissioners signed Order #08-065.

ITEM NO. 10: CONSIDERATION OF MOVING THE OFFICE SPACE OF THE COMMISSION ON CHILDREN AND FAMILIES CURRENTLY LOCATED IN ROOM 133 AT THE NORTHWEST REGIONAL EDUCATION SERVICE DISTRICT TO ROOM 101: Ms. Putman outlined the proposed change of offices within the Education Service District (ESD) Building. The new space is not set up for computer wiring. She will talk with ESD about helping us out financially with the move. She doesn't have specific costs but will work with Michael Soots. Mr. Soots said it will take one (1) person one (1) day.

A motion was made by Commissioner Labhart to approve the move on the condition that Ms. Putman talk with ESD about sharing the costs. Vice-Chair Josi seconded the motion. The motion carried with three (3) aye votes.

ITEM NO. 4: LICENSE APPLICATION FOR NEW OUTLET AND LIMITED OFF-PREMISES SALES FOR THE ORIGINAL NESTUCCA VALLEY SPORTING GOODS AND ANNUAL LIQUOR LICENSE RENEWAL APPLICATIONS FOR ANCHOR INN AND GRILL, BEAVER GROCERY AND DELI, NESKOWIN MARKET PLACE, THE HAWK CREEK CAFÉ, THE SCHOONER: Vice-Chair Josi made a motion to approve the consent calendar. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Labhart. The motion carried with three (3) aye votes. Chair Hurliman signed the License Application for The Original Nestucca Valley Sporting Goods.

ITEM NO. 5: DISCUSSION AND CONSIDERATION OF ORDER IN THE MATTER OF DECLARING A DISASTER WITHIN TILLAMOOK COUNTY DUE TO THE CLOSURE OF THE PACIFIC COAST SALMON FISHERY: Paul Levesque outlined the conditions that led to the disaster declaration. Commissioner Labhart described some of the Federal and State aid that will become available. Vice-Chair Josi said this was not a case of over fishing. He talked about the prior problem in 2002 with the Klamath fish and this year due to the Sacramento River fish that are causing this crisis. Chair Hurliman said fishermen want a healthy industry and they want to look at the entire biomass.

Commissioner Labhart made a motion to approve and sign the Order declaring a disaster within Tillamook County due to the closure of the Pacific Coast salmon fishery. The motion was seconded by Vice-Chair Josi. The motion carried with three (3) aye votes. The Commissioners signed Order #08-063.

ITEM NO. 6: CONSIDERATION OF MODIFICATION #3 TO THE PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH BOLDT, CARLISLE & SMITH, LLC FOR AUDITING SERVICES: Debra Clark said this is for the annual audit. This corrects a discrepancy between the exhibit and the contract.

A motion was made by Vice-Chair Josi to approve and sign Modification #3 to the Professional Services Agreement with Boldt, Carlisle & Smith, LLC for auditing services. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Labhart. The motion carried with three (3) aye votes. The Commissioners signed the Modification.

ITEM NO. 7: CONSIDERATION OF ORDER TRANSFERRING FUNDS BETWEEN BUDGETED LINE ITEMS: Ms. Clark said these cover transfers for the Fair.

Vice-Chair Josi made a motion to approve and sign the Order transferring funds between budgeted line items. Commissioner Labhart seconded the motion. The motion carried with three (3) aye votes. The Commissioners signed Order #08-064.

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ITEM NO. 8: CONSIDERATION OF ALLOCATION CERTIFICATION AGREEMENT FOR MAINTENANCE ASSISTANCE PROGRAM (MAP) WITH THE STATE MARINE BOARD: Del Schleichert said this Forty-Six Thousand (\$46,000) Dollar Agreement is our annual allotment from Marine Board license fees.

A motion was made by Vice-Chair Josi to approve and sign the Allocation Certification Agreement for Maintenance Assistance Program (MAP) with the State Marine Board. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Labhart. The motion carried with three (3) aye votes. Chair Hurliman signed the Agreement.

ITEM NO. 11: CONSIDERATION OF MODIFICATION #1 TO PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT #3841 WITH DAY WIRELESS SYSTEMS FOR PUBLIC SAFETY AND RADIO SITE MAINTENANCE SERVICES: Mr. Soots said this renews the Agreement with a price increase in maintaining our mountaintop sites. They have provided good service.

Vice-Chair Josi made a motion to approve and sign Modification #1 to the Professional Services Agreement #3841 with Day Wireless Systems for public safety and radio maintenance services. Commissioner Labhart seconded the motion. The motion carried with three (3) aye votes. The Commissioners signed the Modification.

ITEM NO. 12: CONSIDERATION OF A RESOLUTION DECLARING JUNE 23 – 29, 2008 AS "AMATEUR RADIO WEEK" IN TILLAMOOK COUNTY: Gordon McCraw and Mr. Soots presented this item. Mr. McCraw said the two (2) represent a large number of HAM operators. He described the field day on June 28 – 29. It will be at the Garibaldi Lumberman's Park. He outlined the benefits of amateur radio. Commissioner Labhart said he witnessed it first hand in the December storm. It is a key link in our emergency system. He strongly supports it. Mr. McCraw said there are three hundred (300) operators in Tillamook County. There were information services that helped in December that weren't affected by the storms. Mr. Soots said our current RACES roster has twenty-three (23) members. Mr. Soots described the training available for HAMS. Mr. McCraw described the technology.

A motion was made by Commissioner Labhart to approve and sign the Resolution declaring June 23 – 29 as "Amateur Radio Week" in Tillamook County. Vice-Chair Josi seconded the motion. The motion carried with three (3) aye votes. The Commissioners signed Resolution #R-08-011.

ITEM NO. 13: CONSIDERATION OF ORDER DISPOSING OF SURPLUS INFORMATION SERVICES EQUIPMENT: Mr. Soots said this equipment no longer has any usefulness and must now be disposed.

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Vice-Chair Josi made a motion to approve and sign the Order disposing of surplus information services equipment. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Labhart. The motion carried with three (3) aye votes. The Commissioners signed Order #08-066.

ITEM NO. 16: PUBLIC HEARING CONCERNING THE 4-H AND EXTENSION SERVICE DISTRICT BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2008-2009: Troy Downing outlined the budget process. He said the Commissioners have been involved.

Chair Hurliman opened the Public Hearing. There being no comment, Chair Hurliman closed the Public Hearing.

ITEM NO. 17: CONSIDERATION OF ORDER ADOPTING THE BUDGET, APPROPRIATING FUNDS, IMPOSING AD VALOREM TAXES, AND CATEGORIZING TAXES FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2008-2009 FOR 4-H AND EXTENSION SERVICE DISTRICT: A motion was made by Vice-Chair Josi to approve and sign the Order adopting the budget, appropriating funds, imposing ad valorem taxes and categorizing taxes for the fiscal year 2008-2009 for the 4-H and Extension Service District. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Labhart. The motion carried with three (3) aye votes. The Commissioners signed Order #08-067 (4-H & ESD #08-005).

ITEM NO. 18: CONSIDERATION OF INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH TILLAMOOK COUNTY 4-H/EXTENSION SERVICE DISTRICT AND THE STATE OF OREGON, ACTING BY AND THROUGH THE STATE BOARD OF HIGHER EDUCATION ON BEHALF OF OREGON STATE UNIVERSITY AND ITS OREGON STATE UNIVERSITY EXTENSION SERVICE FOR THE EXTENSION EDUCATION PROGRAMS IN TILLAMOOK COUNTY: Mr. Downing said this Agreement is to provide Oregon State University service to the District. It is renewed and revised every five (5) years. It clarifies services.

Commissioner Labhart made a motion to approve and sign the Intergovernmental Agreement with Tillamook County 4-H and Extension Service District and the State of Oregon acting by and through the State Board of Higher Education on behalf of Oregon State University and its Oregon State University Extension Service for the extension education programs in Tillamook County. Vice-Chair Josi seconded the motion. The motion carried with three (3) aye votes. The Commissioners signed the Intergovernmental Agreement.

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ITEM NO. 19: CONSIDERATION OF ORDER APPROVING THE FORMATION OF THE NEHALEM VALLEY FIRE AND RESCUE DISTRICT:

Mr. Levesque outlined the petition process, the Board action at the June 2nd hearing and other procedural matters. He noted the Agenda had a misnomer. It should be the Nehalem Bay Fire and Rescue District.

A motion was made by Vice-Chair Josi to approve and sign the Order approving the formation of the Nehalem Bay Fire and Rescue District. Commissioner Labhart seconded the motion. The motion carried with three (3) aye votes. The Commissioners signed Order #08-068.

ITEM NO. 20: CONSIDERATION OF STATE EASEMENT NO. 40254-EA CONCERNING ALL STATE-OWNED SUBMERGED AND SUBMERSIBLE LANDS IN THE TILLAMOOK BAY ABUTTING TAX LOT 200, SECTION 22, TOWNSHIP 1 SOUTH, RANGE 10 WEST, WILLAMETTE MERIDIAN, TILLAMOOK COUNTY, OREGON:

Mr. Levesque said this will acquire an easement from the Department of State Lands for not only the gated spillway but also on the ten (10) floodgates that were completed as an emergency measure more than ten (10) years ago. The Commissioners discussed the Tone Road project as well.

Commissioner Labhart recognized the work of Senator Betsy Johnson and Aaron Palter on these projects.

Commissioner Labhart made a motion to approve and sign the State Easement No. 40254-EA concerning all State-owned submerged and submersible lands in the Tillamook Bay abutting Tax Lot 200, Section 22, Township 1 South, Range 10 West, Willamette Meridian, Tillamook County, Oregon. Vice-Chair Josi seconded the motion. The motion carried with three (3) aye votes. Chair Hurliman signed the Easement.

Chair Hurliman recessed the meeting at 10:04 a.m. and reconvened it at 10:06 a.m.

ITEM NO. 21: CONSIDERATION OF CHANGE ORDER #2 TO CONTRACT FOR GENERAL SERVICES WITH A&E SECURITY AND ELECTRONIC SOLUTIONS FOR CIRCUIT COURT SECURITY SYSTEM PROJECT:

Mr. Levesque said this project installed electronic locks within the State Court spaces and other limited areas of the Courthouse. The Change Order added a few additional doors.

A motion was made by Vice-Chair Josi to approve and sign Change Order #2 to the Contract for General Services with A&E Security and Electronic Solutions for the Circuit Court Security System Project. Commissioner Labhart seconded the motion. The motion carried with three (3) aye votes. The Commissioners signed the Change Order.

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ITEM NO. 22: CONSIDERATION OF LETTER OF INTENT TO JIM BROWN IN THE MATTER OF THE PURCHASE OF 12 (TWELVE) ACRES ADJOINING THE COUNTY-OWNED WILSON WETLAND PARCEL:

Mr. Levesque outlined the mitigation work needed at the Fairgrounds in conjunction with the College parcel and the need for this twelve (12) acre parcel to achieve the mitigation. The County will front the Forty Thousand (\$40,000) Dollars and the College will reimburse the County. A boundary line adjustment will be made on the Fairgrounds/College parcel to offset the College mitigation costs.

Commissioners Labhart made a motion to approve and sign the Letter of Intent to Jim Brown in the matter of the purchase of twelve (12) acres adjoining the County-owned Wilson wetland parcel. Vice-Chair Josi seconded the motion. The motion carried with three (3) aye votes. The Commissioners signed the Letter of Intent.

ITEM NO. 23: CONSIDERATION OF TAX DEED IN FAVOR OF DARCIA WEGNER-OLSEN IN SATISFACTION OF 2003 INSTALLMENT CONTRACT FOR 2N10 3DC

5600: Mr. Levesque said this parcel was purchased under a tax land installment contract in the 2003 land sale. The Twenty-Two Thousand (\$22,000) Dollar purchase price has now been paid in full and the purchaser is entitled to a Deed.

A motion was made by Commissioner Labhart to approve and sign the Tax Deed in favor of Darcia Wegner-Olsen in satisfaction of the 2003 Installment Contract for 2N10 3DC 5600. The motion was seconded by Vice-Chair Josi. The motion carried with three (3) aye votes. The Commissioners signed the Deed.

ITEM NO. 24: BOARD CONCERNS – NON-AGENDA ITEMS & ANNOUNCEMENTS:

Commissioner Labhart announced the June 18 public meeting on wave energy sponsored by Tillamook Intergovernmental Development Entity (TIDE) and the Fisherman's Advisory Council of Tillamook (FACT).

Vice-Chair Josi read the announcements.

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ITEM NO. 25: PUBLIC COMMENTS: There were no comments today.

There being no further business Chair Hurliman adjourned the meeting at 10:18 a.m.

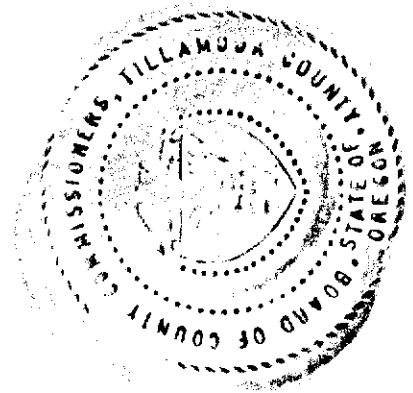

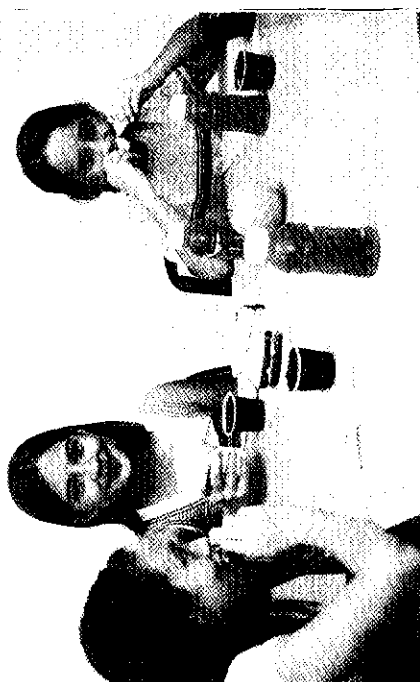

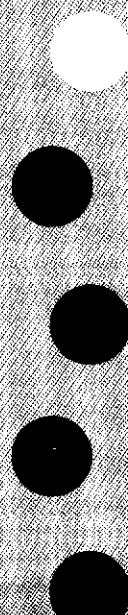
