If employees operate a personal or private vehicle on County business, their personal liability insurance policy is primary and County coverage is excess. If the amount of liability to third parties exceeds their private policy limits, the County will provide excess liability coverage.

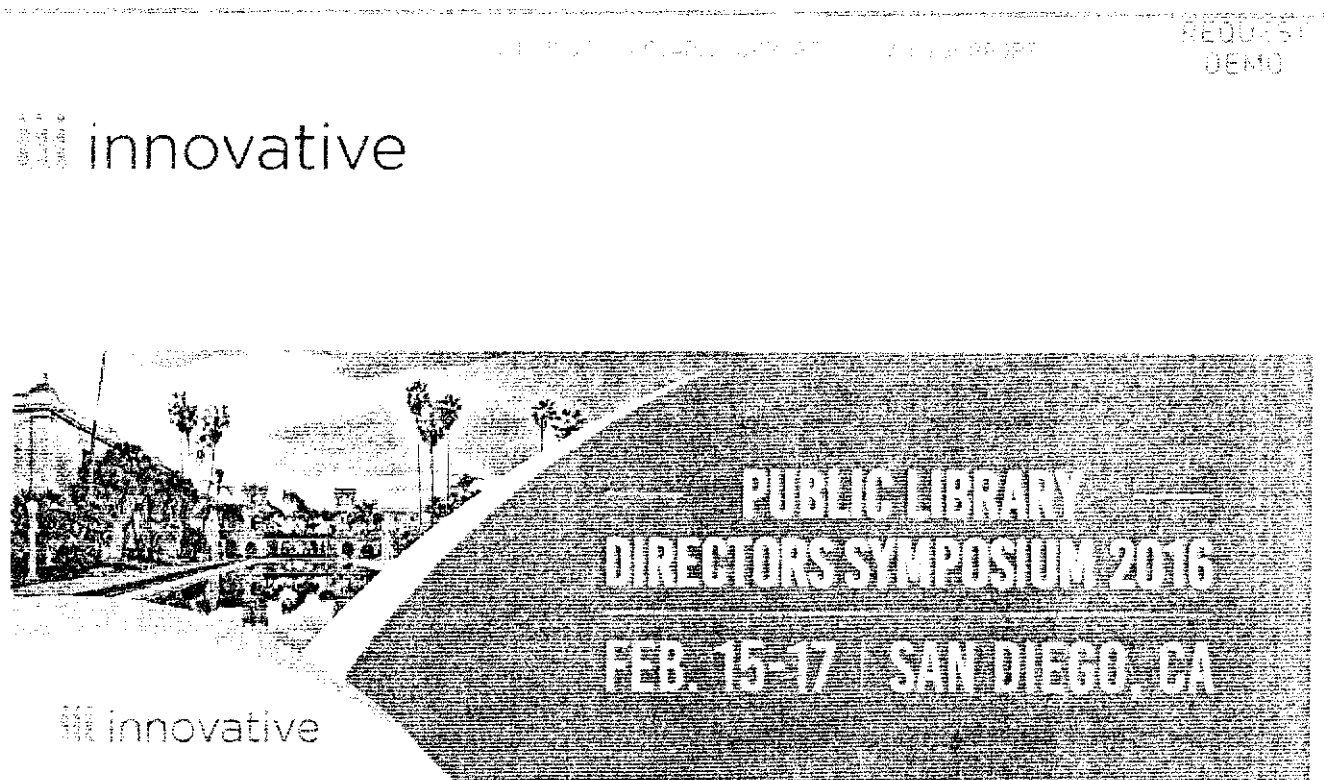
The County does not cover collision or comprehensive insurance for personal vehicles. When utilizing a personal vehicle for County purposes, the employee/agent is 100% responsible for collision or comprehensive damage incurred to the vehicle.

The rationale of having County employees/agents complete a vehicle usage form is for their own knowledge pertaining to County vehicle coverage, and liability protection from the County. Plus, the signed form may give their department head/designee a heads up as to who will be using their own vehicle on County business and committing department funds when claiming reimbursement for personal vehicle mileage. The signing of the personal vehicle usage document will inform the County employee/agent that their insurance is the first to be used in the event of a vehicle accident. Each department should keep a copy of the signed form on file.

If involved in an accident while on official County business, I will advise the Human Resources Department within twenty-four (24) hours by calling 503-842-3418.

Subject: Oregon Honors PERSIAN GULF, AFGHANISTAN and IRAQ War Veterans with Memorial Signs on US Highway 101

Dear Tillamook County Commissioners and County Veterans Service Officer.

Over the last seven years, Bend Heroes Foundation has requested the Oregon legislature and Governors to adopt laws that would honor nearly one-half million Oregon veterans who served in 5 major wars during the last 98 years: **WWI, WWII, Korean War, Vietnam War and Persian Gulf, Afghanistan and Iraq War**. Over 6,000 veterans made the supreme sacrifice with another 15,000 wounded during those wars.

The honors will be accomplished by 67 large signs installed along Oregon's 5 major highways. Thirty eight (38) signs have already been installed on US Hwy 395 (**WWI Veterans**), US Hwy 97 (**WWII Veterans**), I-5 (**Korean War Veterans** and **Purple Heart Trail**) and I-84 (**Vietnam War Veterans**). Soon 10 signs honoring **Persian Gulf, Afghanistan and Iraq War Veterans** will be installed on US Hwy 101. This is the first highway of its type in our nation. Attached is a fact sheet describing the overall project. Please note the photos of appreciative veterans with THEIR signs.

The honors to Oregon's 90,000 Veterans who served during the **Persian Gulf, Afghanistan and Iraq Wars** during the last 25 years, the 112 who lost their lives and the nearly 700 who were wounded will be accomplished by 10 large signs installed along US 101 - a major well traveled, scenic and border-to-border highway totaling 338 miles in length. Below is a photo of one of 2 signs to be installed and dedicated near Warrenton next month.

Approximately 86,000 Persian Gulf, Afghanistan and Iraq Veterans live in Oregon today. They represent about 25% of the 331,000 veterans living in Oregon. Approximately 2,444 veterans live in Tillamook County with about 635 having served during the Persian Gulf, Afghanistan and Iraq Wars.

Twelve (12) veterans who lived along US 101 made the supreme sacrifice during those wars beginning 25 years ago.

The signs will be paid for by veterans groups, County Commissions, civic organizations and individuals. Bend Heroes Foundation collects the donations and pays Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) \$900 to fabricate and install each of the 10 signs on US 101. Payment must be made before signs can be installed and dedicated.

Twelve County Commissions donated between \$500 and \$2,700 for veterans memorial highway signs on US 97, US 395 and I-84. The Tillamook Board of County Commissioners now has an opportunity to join that group by sponsoring 1 sign near Tillamook at \$900.

Highway dedication ceremonies have been held at County Court Houses and veterans facilities. Guest speakers, veterans, donors, the public, families of veterans who gave their lives and media will be invited to dedications along US 101. The first sign dedication will be held at Camp Rilea in Warrenton in early January, 2016 as 2 signs near there have been funded.

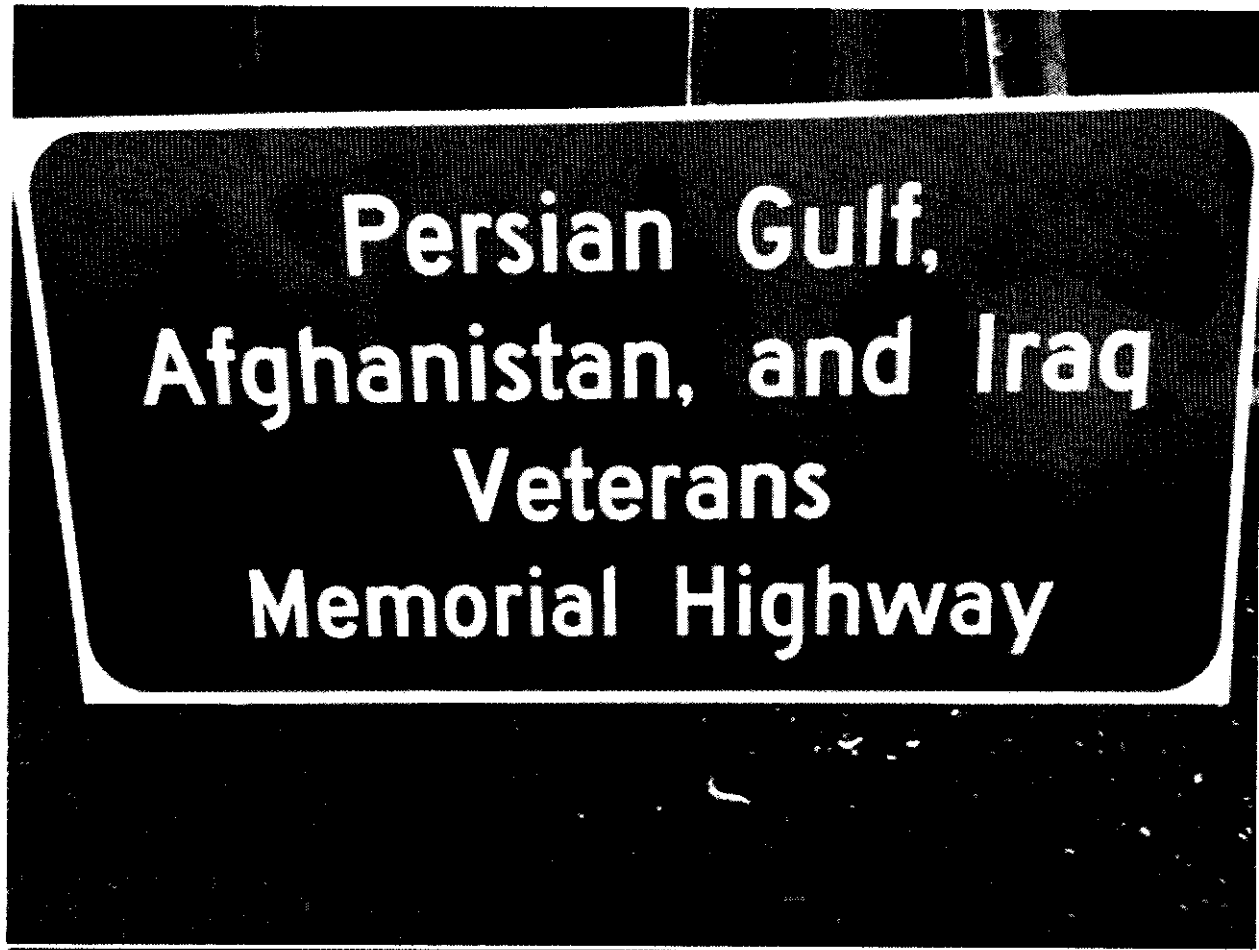


Photo of 4 ft. x 8 ft. Persian Gulf, Afghanistan and Iraq Veterans Memorial Highway sign

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
ON PROPOSED TILLAMOOK COUNTY ORDINANCE #79
CONCERNING REPEALING AMENDED TILLAMOOK COUNTY
ORDINANCE #76

Notice is hereby given that two (2) Public Hearings shall be held before the Board of Commissioners for Tillamook County pursuant to ORS 203.045 (3). The first Public Hearing shall be held on December 23, 2015 at 10:30 a.m. in the Commissioners' Conference Room A of the Tillamook County Courthouse, 201 Laurel Avenue, Tillamook, Oregon 97141. The second Public Hearing shall be held on January 6, 2016 at 10:30 a.m. in the Commissioners' Conference Room A of the Tillamook County Courthouse, 201 Laurel Avenue, Tillamook, Oregon 97141.

The two (2) public hearings were originally noticed on December 2, 2015 to be held on December 9th and December 23rd. County offices were closed December 9th due to severe weather conditions, resulting in the cancellation of the December 9th Board meeting. The County elects to retain the December 23rd public hearing date for the first hearing.

The purpose of these Public Hearings will be to receive public testimony concerning Proposed Ordinance #79 repealing amended Tillamook County Ordinance #76. Ordinance #76 establishes a moratorium of medical marijuana facilities in any area subject to the jurisdiction of Tillamook County. An Amendment of Ordinance #76 extends the moratorium until January 31, 2016. The reasons for the enactment of Ordinance #76 and its amendment no longer exist. The state has enacted rules and regulations pertaining to recreational and medical marijuana and the Board has decided that it will not enact time, place, and manner regulations concerning medical or recreational marijuana at this time.

All persons are welcome to submit written testimony in this matter to the County Board of Commissioners, 201 Laurel Avenue, Tillamook, Oregon 97141 or to appear and testify at the Public Hearings.

The Tillamook County Courthouse is accessible to persons with disabilities.
