**Final Ballot Title** The following is the final ballot title of the measure to be submitted to the district's voters. The ballot title notice has been published and the ballot title challenge process has been completed.

Five-year operating levy for fire and emergency medical services.

**Question** 20 words which plainly phrases the chief purpose of the measure.

Should Nestucca RFPD issue a local operating levy for fire and emergency services for five years beginning in 2019-2020? This may cause property taxes to increase more than three percent.

**Summary** 175 words which concisely and impartially summarizes the measure and its major effect.

The measure, if approved would authorize the District to levy taxes to support the annual cost of fire and emergency medical services including an additional six (6) new employees. The measure would provide for a local option operating levy at a rate not to exceed \$0.66 cents per \$1000 of taxable assessed value within the District for five years, beginning July 1, 2019. Revenue from the levy would be used to maintain adequate staffing with the goal of assuring adequate response time. The estimated revenue over five years is:

The number of calls for service has incrementally increased. The District's goal with this levy would be to fund three of the existing positions, a Captain and two firefighters, and hire 6 new employees.
